Project Focus: Uttar Pradesh Rural Roads

Construction & Maintenance of Rural Roads under Full Depth Reclamation with StabilRoad



A project that set the record for completing 2.5 Lane Kms in a day on October 22, 2022, with Full Depth Recycling, these roads are the arteries for the State of Uttar Pradesh. Roads that connect villages, cities and other towns.

Full Depth Recycling or Reclamation, a pavement rehabilitation technique in which the full flexible pavement section and a predetermined portion of the underlying materials are uniformly pulverized and blended together to produce a homogeneous stabilized base course. This technology is used in the construction of pavements with cement and the additive powder StabilRoad – a 100% mineral based additive from Germany.

This binding agent makes the soil very resistant to compressive strength as well as elastic, waterproof and frost resistant.

Problem Statement in the Project:

• The roads were severely distressed, with cracks and the top layer worn off

Inadequate carriageway width




Challenges faced:

- The tenders were called for to rehabilitate and widen the existing pavement by Full Depth Reclamation (FDR) technology without any borrowed material (bringing in outside material except the Bituminous top layers).
- The work is being carried out without interrupting running traffic, leaving no space for diversions or alternate paths

Terrain:

Plain predominantly Soil Type: Silty Soil

Weather Conditions:



Heavy rains, extreme cold conditions

The Vishwa Samudra Solution:

The existing pavement material being insufficient to form the required width and thickness of stabilized base, it was decided to reclaim the existing subgrade material along with the existing pavement crust. Proportionate design mixes were created accordingly to arrive at the solution.

The existing pavement material was scarified and spread over the required width and recycled to the required depth. This includes a certain proportion of subgrade material with optimum cement and StabilRoad dosages to form the designed thickness of stabilized base.

Setting an Example:

Not only did this project set a record for building 2.5 Lane Kms in less than 12 hours, but the Uttar Pradesh Govt. also demonstrated the FDR process in this project to the Road Authorities of over 26 States in India. The project continues to be an active example of exemplary technology and ingenuity in road construction with several visits by various road authorities frequently.



Built for withstanding the powerful impact of waves and protect against coastal erosion, their shape, size, weight and dimensions depend on the coastal conditions needed for the marine structure.

The Indopods used in the construction of the Breakwaters of the Mulapeta Port, Andhra Pradesh are made from high-strength concrete with excellent resistance to saltwater corrosion, ensuring long-term durability in harsh coastal environments. These structures are designed and developed depending on the wave height, as they help in dissipating wave energy efficiently. When waves crash against the blocks, the energy is dispersed through hydraulic friction and turbulence, reducing the erosive impact on the coastline.

VSE's indigenous design and mould engineering approach to create Indopods have benefited the group's marine projects over the years. From the glorious Krishnapatnam Port to the current Mulapeta Port, Indopods have become ideal structures for coastal protection compared to other alternatives like natural stone.

With the advantage of being low in maintenance and easy to install, their applicability across marine projects is wide, making them a popular choice for breakwaters.



These Indopods have been designed in-house by one of India's most experienced Harbour Engineers in addition to being tested and certified by IITs and other reputed institutes across the country.


We interviewed our Chief Health Officer Dr. Sudha Yendluri to understand more about this vital initiative.
