

Kannur, a beautiful city in the Indian state of Kerala known for its beaches, natural treasures, folk art, temples and loom industries, has one of the key projects of VSE.


The Thaliparambha-Muzhapilangad Kannur 6-lane highway NHAI project, currently under construction, almost halfway through, is one of VSE's most important projects in the State of Kerala.

VSE's innovative approach in completing this project makes it stand out from the rest, with our excellence in infrastructure going a long way in assisting the economic upliftment of the entire Kannur region. The Vishwa Samura stamp of Quality and Reliability will be setting gold standards for future projects in and around the region.





A highly challenging project, the entire stretch passes through 12 villages of Kannur district with a length of 29.948 kms. This long stretch is entirely characterized by a 6-lane carriageway with drainage and service roads on both sides. The project road crosses a major river, a few minor streams and adequate paddy land. The general terrain along the road is plain with intermittent stretches under rolling.



NHAI has accorded the approval for using the sustainable Stabil-Road technology, resulting in a total saving of 68,000 MT of aggregate being saved.





Salient Features of this Project:


- The Project has 3.6 kms of designated Ground Improvement Area (GIA) with marine clay as parent soil.
- The Project has more than 70% of precast box culverts executed at site
- Other than the designated GIA, the project has a requirement of 5.3 kms if ground improvement under RE wall and structures.
- Various ground improvement techniques such as soil replacement, gravel replacement, PVD, stone columns, soil replacement with paralink are used in the project.
- Edge protection by wrap around system has been executed here
- It includes a 55 m navigational span with composite steel for MJB

The meeting comprehensively addresses and discusses the below mentioned criteria:

- Implementation of VS group Safety Management System
- Adherence to the VSE Health Safety Environment & Quality Policy (HSEQ)
- Compliance of the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)
- Any Safety Violation by the Employees and/or Contractors during last month and corrective action for the same
- Innovative ideas to enhance safety at site and prevention of incidents

Safety Inspection & Checklist:

There are daily, weekly, monthly safety inspection & checklists to ensure that equipment, machineries, vehicle and fire extinguishers are in good condition to execute the work safely.





Permit To Work (PTW):

A mandatory written document which needs to be taken by the concerned department, to execute an activity safely by fulfilling the conditions of it. (Types of PTW – Hot Work Permit, Height Work Permit, Excavation Work Permit, Electrical Work Permit, Lifting Work Permit, Cold Work Permit, Confined Space Permit etc).



Monthly Safety Promotional Activities:

This program is conducted in the presence of the following members.

1.Department Section Heads

2.Project Heads

3.Staff & workers

This program thoroughly delves into the following points, ensuring a comprehensive discussion of each.

- Any on-site or industry-related incidents/accidents prompt a thorough review, and immediate preventive actions are taken to enhance safety measures, instil awareness, and prevent recurrence at our own site and across the construction industry.
- Violation (if any) of VSE's HSEQ policy will have corrective & preventive consequences for the same.
- Sharing of knowledge by experienced staff to improve skills & safety awareness.



Daily Toolbox Talk:

A small safety meeting done religiously every day, at every shift by the safety officer with workers involved in that activity. TBT is carried out before starting an activity to refresh them about the hazard(s), risk(s) and their control(s).





Reward and Recognition Program:

Workers/Employees are rewarded for:

- Reporting/Correcting the 'Unsafe Act', 'Unsafe
 Condition' & 'Near Miss Situation' which can lead to
 an incident resulting in injury, illness, property
 damage or harm to the environment.
- Reward for the 'Best Safety Practice', 'Best Safety Observer' of the month.
- Quiz program conducted on various safety subjects to improve safety awareness and to motivate the work force for an active participation.







Installation of Safety Sign Boards & Slogans: For safe traffic management, as a reminder to exercise safety and to provide warning for hazards in that area.









Firefighting trainings:

Live demo and hands-on experience provided to the employees and workers to develop confidence & skill to meet any exigency.





On Job Training (OJT):

Workers are given On Job Trainings for the works they are allotted, to improve skills, productivity, and ensure safe work environment.



Safety in project activities::

All activities of the project are listed and categorized in high, medium & low risk. Each activity is covered with SOP and is strictly implemented for safe execution. Utmost care is taken for High Risk (Critical Activity) and predefined Colour Coded Zones in RED, YELLOW and GREEN are created to safeguard workers, property & environment by placing coloured markers/flags and barricading. For example while I-Girder launching activity is taking place, RED zone is NO MAN area, YELLOW zone – only concerned staff/workers are allowed & in GREEN zone – staff/workers who are not involved in the activity, can take rest here.

KAKINADA ANCHORAGE PORT

Owned and operated by the Andhra Pradesh Maritime Board, the Kakinada Anchorage Port serves as a crucial gateway for the agricultural regions of East Godavari, West Godavari, and Krishna districts in Andhra Pradesh. To promote port-led development across India's coastline, the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways launched the Sagarmala Programme. As part of this flagship initiative, Sagaramala Development Company Limited (SDCL) identified Kakinada Anchorage Port as a potential investment location for improvement and development.

Project: Improvement of Kakinada Anchorage Port Facilities under Sagarmala Programme

Scope of Work: To enhance the infrastructure and capabilities of the Port:

Construction of two wharves (90m and 110m length) for mechanical handling
Construction of loading points (5 no. of 25m each) in new port area
Strengthening of Existing roads (1.14 Km length)
Special repairs to existing groynes and revetments (140,000 MT of rocks)
Dredging of Commercial canal and Approach channel at Kakinada Anchorage (254,000 cum)

Tech Adoption in Construction Industry

In today's fast-paced and ever-evolving world, technology plays a pivotal role in shaping industries across the board. Sectors like construction are no exception. While some companies have embraced technological advancements with open arms, others have been reluctant to change. Construction industries have historically been slow to adopt new technologies. However, in today's competitive global market, staying up to date with technological advancements is crucial. Failure to adopt and integrate technology can lead to inefficiencies, decreased competitiveness, and financial setbacks.

Tech Adoption by Industry

Importance of different transformation areas

A survey conducted by the World Economic Forum and Boston Consulting Group, ranking the transformation areas of the E&C industry according to their importance, concluded 'adoption of new technology, materials, and tools' as the second highest next to people.






As per the survey conducted by McKinsey, the low adoption of technology in the construction industry has been a notable trend. While the construction

sector has been slow to adopt process and technology innovations, there is also a continuing challenge when it comes to fixing the basics like project planning, contract management, R&D, etc. Spending on information technology accounts for less than 1 percent of revenues for construction, even though several new software solutions have been developed for the industry.

Embracing The New Technology Focused Construction Industry

According to the McKinsey Global Institute, digital innovation and transformation can provide significant improvements in productivity (about 15%) and reduce costs (around 6%). Despite being historically slow at implementing cutting-edge technologies, construction industry leaders are embracing the change. Companies that support the implementation of new technologies will see an increased advantage in the next few decades.
