#### **Pioneering Progress**

Set against the backdrop of scenic Jammu and Kashmir, the Jammu Expressway Project is poised to redefine infrastructural standards with its innovative approach and ambitious goals. What sets this project apart is its pioneering use of four distinct elevated corridors, each spanning an impressive 5.4 kilometres. Notably, these corridors boast a width of 34 meters, making them the longest of their kind under execution by our company in India.

In a deviation from the norm, the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has allocated a streamlined timeline of just two years for the project's completion, a testament to its urgency and significance. With unwavering determination, our team is committed to not only meeting but surpassing this deadline, showcasing our dedication to efficiency and excellence.





Central to the project's success are the three specially designed launching girders, tailored to facilitate the construction of the elevated corridors. Moreover, the incorporation of High-Density Rubber Bearings (HDRB) underscores our commitment to seismic resilience, with this technology being a rarity in India. These heavy-duty bearings, with a thickness of 1000 mm, exemplify our proactive approach to safety and durability.

Furthermore, the scale of the project is immense, with 14 moulds being fabricated at a cost of INR 40 crores to cast approximately 1800 segments. Additionally, the construction of a formidable Reinforced Earth Wall (RE wall) spanning 3.5 lakh square meters underscores the magnitude of the undertaking. Notably, the Jammu Project represents an expressway signalling a significant leap forward in the region's transportation infrastructure.

While the project embraces innovation, it also stays rooted in tradition, opting for conventional roads using the green technology from Germany, StabilRoad. This deliberate choice reflects our commitment to utilizing methods best suited to the project's requirements, ensuring optimal outcomes and a lasting impact. As the Jammu Project unfolds, it not only promises enhanced connectivity and accessibility but also serves as a beacon of progress and possibility for the region and beyond.








#### Shaping Breakwaters: Indopods at the Mulapeta Port



VSE installs the first Indopod at the Mulapeta Port in Andhra Pradesh on March 8, 2024 in the presence of VS Group Chairman Mr. Chinta Sasidhar & VSE MD Dr. Anil Yendluri. VSE's Indopods have been revolutionising breakwaters over the years - from its introduction at the glorious Krishnapatnam Port to the current Mulapeta Port, Indopods have become ideal structures for coastal protection compared to other alternatives like natural stone.

The Indopods used in the construction of the Breakwaters of the Mulapeta Port, Andhra Pradesh are made from high-strength concrete with excellent resistance to saltwater corrosion, ensuring long-term durability in harsh coastal environments. These structures are designed and developed depending on the wave height, as they help in dissipating wave energy efficiently. When waves crash against the blocks, the energy is dispersed through hydraulic friction and turbulence, reducing the erosive impact on the coastline.

VSE's indigenous design and mould engineering approach to create Indopods have benefited the group's marine projects over the years. With the advantage of being low in maintenance and easy to install, their applicability across marine projects is wide, making them a popular choice for breakwaters.

#### **India Incenlists** military veterans to lead crack teams

As the country celebrated the 75th Republic Day, an enduring image was the parade at Delhi's Karravya Path. Besides tableaus showcasing India's rich cultural heritage, the millitary might of the country's armed forces was on full display. And India line was paying close attention. Once retired, personnel from the defence forces, after all, make for ready talent. From cybersecurity to logistics and operations to human resources (HR), companies such as Amazon India, Tata Motors, ONGC, EverEnviro and Visiwa Samudra group are already bolstering

Tata Motors, for instance, is "currently developing a programme to systematically incorporate military talent as a key hiring channel," says Ravindra Kumar, president and chief human resources

president and chief human resources officer. Several veterans work in logistics and supply chain, procurement, and cybersecurity at the firm, and the automaker is actively looking to hire more. Some, such as Amazon India, have tied up with the Directorate General Resettlement — the defence ministry body that works on pre- and post-retirement training, re-employment and selfemployment of ex-servicemen — and the placement agencies of the navy, air force army, and most recently, the Indian Coast Guard. The e-tailer also hires military vet-erans and transitioning service personne

ONGc. meanwhile, says the integration of army personnel into the country's largest crude oil and natural gas product is seamless. "Both organisations have genesis in remote areas with challenging errain, and are often deployed in border areas with tough climatic conditions," says a company sookesperson. The Delhi-

At the India unit of multinational banking giant JPMorgan Chase, MVs work in finance, operations, technology, analytics, project management, information security management, and business management, says Deapsk Mangla, chief executive officer, corporate centres, India and Philippines, JPMorgan Chase.

Transferability of skills is the most potent weapon in the arsenal of MVs. say industry executives and experts. The time that MVs speed leading teams, and in strategic decision-making and crisis management roles allows them to seamlessly take up corporate positions.

But hiring MVs isn't without its share of challenges. "Most of them join the defence services at a very young age. The excitement when they were young is depleted by the time they join us, and it takes longer for them to adapt to the company culture," says an ONGC spokesperson. With proper training, however, the veterans come to understand the values, vision and mission of the public sector undertaking, the spokesperson adds.

To be sure, the walk from the battle-ground to the boardroom isn't that long. Corporate offices, after all, may not sound that different with terms such as "war room" and price "war" thrown around

and a key focus being the "battle" for pre mium buyers and "capturing" a larger slice of the "target" market. Yet, adjusting to the civilian work envi-ronment can be tough. MVs are accus-

"Effort is often required to rebrand or contextualise military experience to emphasise the relevance of acquired skills in a manner that resonates with civilian employers," says Delshad Master, who retired as squadron leader and is now associate vice-president, Careernet Prism, which focuses on diversity, equity and inclusion (DED hiring, Master, who spent a decade with the Indian Air Froce training pilots and airmen at forward air bases, says while veterans undergo transition says while veterans undergo transition programmes to adapt to civilian life, com-panies need to sensitise and educate thei civilian workforce by addressing biases

civilian workforce by addressing biases rund miscenceptions about vectorans.

Buddy' programmes, like the one at diversified civil construction multinational Vishwa Samudra group, help. The Telangana-based company pairs a current employee with a new MV team member for smooth onboarding, says Executive Director Shivdutt Das.

Those sekted at Pilphart are provided personalised induction, sensitisation, and curated learning programmes to facilitate a seamless transition, says Prajakta Kanaglekar, vice president, supply chain and customer experience.

While India Inc is engaging more with MVs as a separate talent pool, a navy veteran of 25 years, who spoke on the condition of anonymity, has a word of advice. The ITT Madras alumin handled operations and maintenance of cutting-edge weapon and sensor networks. - Over 320 cattle at the 230 acre facility: Bulls, Cows and Calves
- Over 05 varieties of Indian bull breeds are present and conserved at the facility
- Every morning at around 4 am, their urine is collected (to make fertilizers)
- The cattle are left out to graze by 7:30 am and get back to the shelter by 3:30 pm
- · During this time the shelters are cleaned
- The collected urine and dung are mixed in a designated area where a mixture is created that is used as a natural fertilizer for the plants in the facility
- The facility has close to 15 pairs of bulls who have been specifically trained for Bullock Cart
- · The cows at the facility give milk of A2 grade
- Once the Nandha Gokulam Life School is functional, every student will be given 2 cows each with who they will spend 1 2 hours
  every day, therefore creating an important human-animal bond which is a crucial learning experience needed for every kid





- The breeding of Bulls at the facility will follow the natural process unlike the unnatural processes of artificial insemination or other similar approaches. The process is recorded and all details tracked throughout the course of the bull and its offspring.
- · An average of INR 10 Lakhs is spent every month for the maintenance of these cattle
